Last entry is 20 minutes before closing time. Locker facilities are available for a £5 refundable hire fee (card payments only).

The swimming pool has an adult:child ratio*:

- **For children aged 2 and under:** 1 adult : 1 child
- **For children aged 3-13:** 1 adult : 2 children

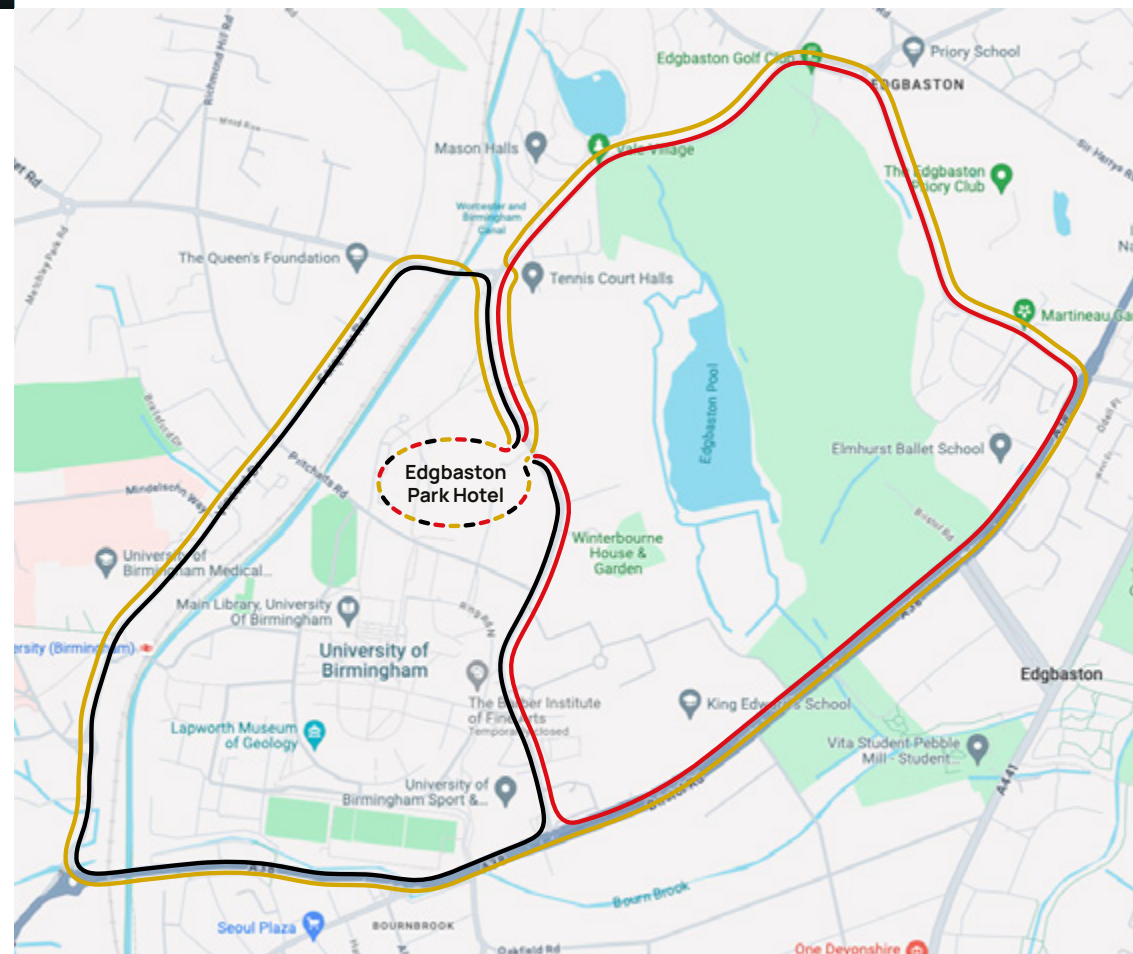
*The adult must be within reach of the child at all times. Children aged 14 and over may swim unsupervised.

- Free admission

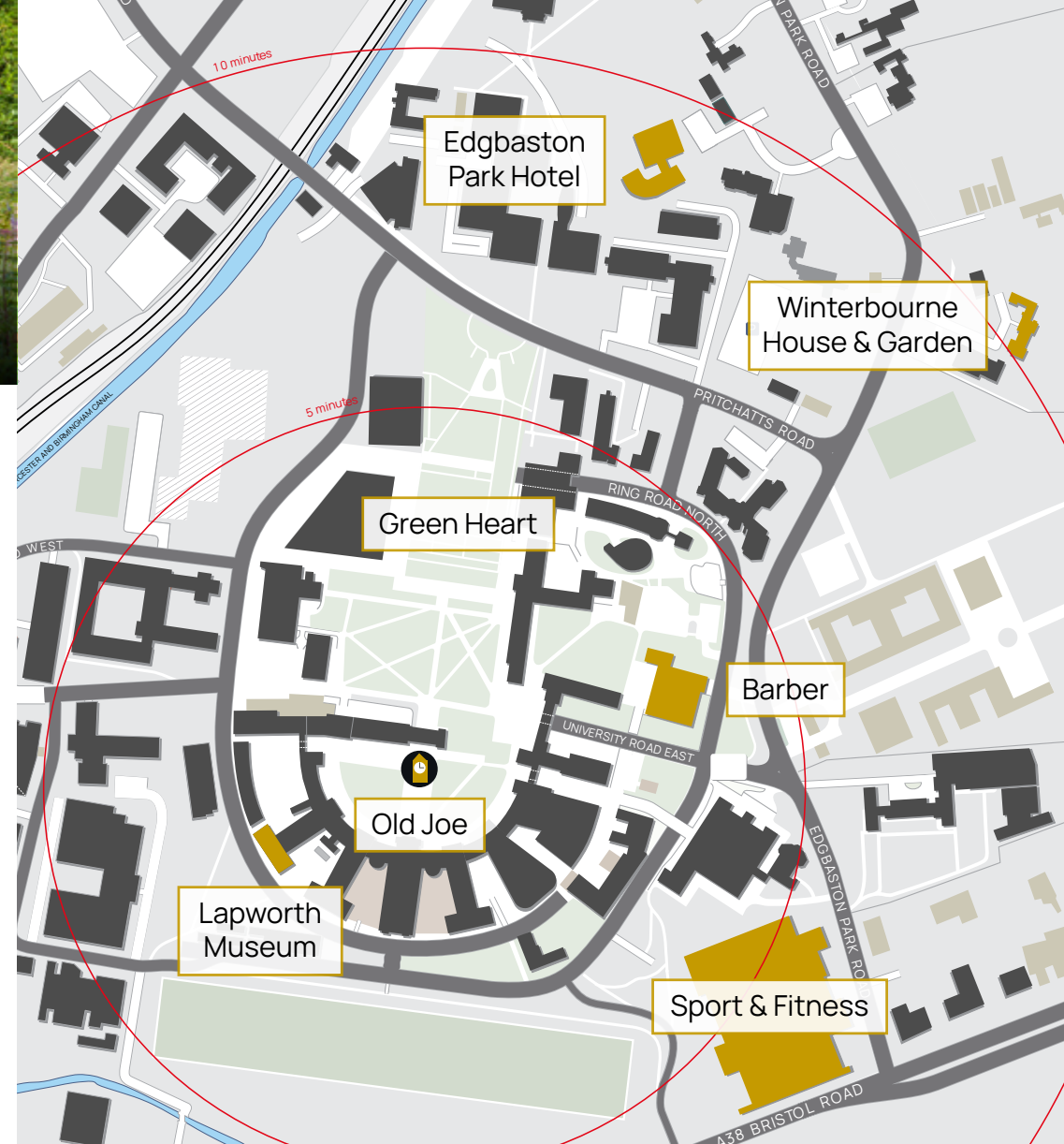
